THE BASIC NEEDS

FOOD PANTRY

1 in 5 Westchester County residents is food-insecure. In 2022, Our "Food Market" helped fill the gap for almost 3,000 Northern Westchester families. In our choice style food pantry clients can choose the items they want, including meat, eggs and fresh produce.

We are grateful for the generous donations and food drives from the community which help us stock our shelves, but we must still purchase nearly 2/3 of the food we distribute.

It costs the Center over \$275,000 annually to keep the Pantry shelves filled with nutritious food to meet the growing need.

CLOTHING BOUTIQUE

In 2022, our generous local community donated 247,394 pounds of gently used clothing, shoes and linens to our free-of-charge "Clothing Boutique".

Our families can select from a wide variety of clothing, including warm winter wear, outfits appropriate for interviews and work, clothing for children in school and athletic attire so kids can participate in sports.

The Community Center not only reduces hunger by offering healthful food but also supports our neighbors with programs and resources for better mental health and physical well-being.

We offer:

- Free health screenings and flu shots by the NWH community outreach team
- Access to free eye exams and eyeglasses with LensCrafters One Sight Foundation
- Nutrition counseling and workshops for individuals and families
- Collaboration with local agencies and organizations to meet our clients' needs through seamless referrals
- Scholarships to local and sleep away camps for children to make new friends and enjoy nature
- On-site access to MHA Westchester mental health services
- One-on-one support for anyone needing extra help to overcome difficult and unique challenges

SELF-SUFFICIENCY

CCNW offers targeted programs for our clients to gain the skills they seek to secure stable employment, earn higher pay and improve quality of life for the entire family. These free programs provide focused job skill training with bilingual instructors, and the course content and scheduling that participants need to achieve their personal goals.

We offer:

GRATITUDE

As a young mother I found myself in a single parent situation. I was forced to find resources and services that would assist me emotionally, mentally and in some cases financially to help keep my young family afloat. It was during these times that I was introduced to CCNW.

As I moved along and was able to regain my footing I was able to utilize the Pantry less and less, and it's funny because you're going along and you don't even realize that you're not coming every month anymore and then once again I'm blindsided and the trajectory of my life takes an unsuspecting turn and I'm looking for ways to once again make ends meet.

I remember pulling up in the parking lot and just sitting in my car, almost ashamed...having a conversation with myself, telling "me" it's ok, just go in! So I take a gulp of air and swallow my pride and I go in and then it comes back to me. I had forgotten what a caring, accepting, judge-less environment the team had created at the Community Center.

Everyone that works or volunteers understands that for a lot of folks walking through those doors does not come easy. For some it's a feeling of failure and shame.

But when they greet you, upstairs or down their smiles pull you in...their voices comfort you and all of a sudden you're not looking down but your head is up and you have found the courage to look the person standing in front of you in the eyes.

Now some may say this is all pretty dramatic over a bag of food, but it's not just a bag of food...It is a silent scream of encouragement. It's that metaphorical pat on the back that says "it's OK. We're here for you!" ...An unsolicited act of caring that can only come from someone who cares...It's continued hope for better days.

I'm not sure if the Community Center has a battle cry but if it doesn't it should, and it should definitely be... It's not a hand out, it's a hand up!

LOVING OUR CHILDREN

1 in 10 children in Westchester lives in poverty. Our relationships with families has taught us that the best way to help those in financial crisis is to first meet the needs of their children, because as families struggle to make ends meet, children bear the brunt. Families report reduced stress and greater peace of mind when their children have their needs met.

In 2022 we:

- Provided for over 400 babies by offering diapers, wipes, formula, and baby food to their families.
- Supported 1,800 local children with brand-new school supplies.
- 100 high school seniors attended their Senior Proms in style with beautiful donated formal wear.
- Awarded 21 students with scholarships to support their continued education to achieve their academic goals.
- Kept 1,500 children warm during the winter with new pajamas, hats and gloves.

CARING FOR OUR SENIORS

8% of seniors in Westchester live in poverty. These neighbors are often struggling to stay in their homes and must make hard choices each month between paying bills, buying medicine, paying rent or putting food on their table. Our choice pantry and clothing program help to meaningfully reduce stress for seniors by supporting their basic needs, and for our homebound seniors we deliver monthly groceries.

In 2022 we:

- Supported over 600 seniors living on limited budgets, with food, clothing and essential needs.
- Made 552 home deliveries to provide groceries and emotional support to our local homebound seniors.
- Aided 79 seniors who reached out to us for help for the first time.
- Provided access to free health screenings, flu shots, eyeglasses, nutrition counseling and more.


